

The inspiration for The Izzy Foundation came from Isabelle Marie Wohlrab (Izzy), who was diagnosed with Stage 4 rhabdomyosarcoma cancer two weeks after her first birthday. Over the next 2 ½ years, Izzy maintained an incredible spirit and spread joy and happiness to everyone who met her. Through her grace and determination, she showed everyone that she reached a glimpse of just how beautiful life can be. Even after Izzy earned her angel wings, she has inspired her parents, family, friends and countless others to continue with her philosophy to **LIVE, LOVE, LAUGH AND PLAY** through The Izzy Foundation. Initially created to defray the costs of Izzy's stem-cell transplant in Germany, the Foundation now seeks to design spaces, provide services and support to children with cancer and their families by implementing inpatient and outpatient services for pediatric patients at Hasbro Hospital, in Providence, Rhode Island and nationwide.



Since 2011, when we began our IZspirational journey, we have raised over \$1,600,000 through fundraisers, donations, merchandise sales and various other initiatives.

Together we have made it possible to provide many services for the families of pediatric cancer patients. "NATASHA'S STORY"



In February and March of 2018, my daughter, Natasha Roy had been experiencing some aching in her lower leg on and off, mostly at bedtime. Although she continued to be very active, I decided to take her to the Urgent Care on Tuesday, March 6th. I will always remember this date because, after an exam and x-ray, the doctor informed me that there was a definite problem with the tibia bone and that she needed to get on crutches right away.

After a whirlwind of MRI's, biopsy and bone scans, Natasha was diagnosed with Osteosarcoma. She began chemo at Hasbro on March 28th then had surgery in Boston in July. She continued with chemo in August and is expected to finish at the end of November. All of the doctors, nurses, and support staff at Hasbro Children's Hospital go above and beyond to provide exceptional care and to treat the patients and their families like they are their own family members.

Additionally, Natasha and I, along with our entire large family and friends, became fixtures in the Izzy Family Room. The Izzy Foundation has done a remarkable job creating a very warm, comforting environment to hang out in. The lunches provided several times a week are an enormous help and opportunity to meet with other families going through similar circumstances. Natasha always asks "Is there any leftover pizza or pasta in the Izzy Room?"

She has taken part in many of the activities in The Izzy Family Room, such as visits from the Bring Your Own Improv group, NE Revolution soccer team and the many craft sessions provided by volunteers and interns, just to name a few. The last event that Natasha attended was the Halloween Dinner where, in her words "I got to meet Izzy's family!!" That was the highlight, although she also loved getting to paint the faces of many of the adults in attendance, including Izzy's parents!

Natasha, I and our family cannot begin to show how grateful we are for the work of The Izzy Foundation. My family has attended the Foundation's fundraisers and knows how necessary it is for people and organizations to provide support and donations for this cause. Unfortunately, there will continue to be many other patients like Natasha and they and their families would be lost without the help of The Izzy Foundation, so please consider donating.



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
