A YEAR IN REVIEW!

In August 2019, The Izzy Foundation unveiled the new Surgical Waiting Area - an Izzy Space. This family waiting room is a vast 950 square feet, located on the second floor of Hasbro Children's Hospital. This warm environment offers families of children undergoing surgery a modern waiting room with multiple comfortable areas of respite including a kitchen with coffee and snacks provided by the Foundation. More importantly, we created a consultation space for surgeons to meet with families to provide the privacy needed when hearing the news of their child's procedure. The new Peri-Operative Service Liaison helps guide families, providing a seamless surgical experience. This special space would not have been possible without the expertise and design of Thomas Morbitzer and his team at AM/MOR Architecture LLP. They have once again outdone themselves and we are filled with tremendous gratitude for their efforts. Together we have created our third Izzy space, as the newly opened Surgical Waiting Area joins the Izzy Family Room and the Izzy Playground in North Carolina.

The inspiration for The Izzy Foundation came from Isabelle Marie Wohlrab (Izzy), who was diagnosed with Stage 4 rhabdomyosarcoma cancer two weeks after her first birthday. Over the next 2 ½ years, Izzy maintained an incredible spirit and spread joy and happiness to everyone who met her. Through her grace and determination, she showed everyone that she reached a glimpse of just how beautiful life can be. Even after Izzy earned her angel wings, she has inspired her parents, family, friends and countless others to continue with her philosophy to **LIVE, LOVE, LAUGH** and **PLAY** through The Izzy Foundation. Initially created to defray the costs of Izzy's stem-cell transplant in Germany, the Foundation now seeks to design spaces and provide services to support children with cancer and their families by implementing inpatient and outpatient services for pediatric patients at Hasbro Children's Hospital, in Providence, Rhode Island and nationwide.

Since 2011, when we began our IZspirational journey, we have raised over **\$1.8 million** through fundraisers, donations, merchandise sales and various other initiatives.

Together we have made it possible to provide many services for the families whose children have pediatric cancer and other life altering medical conditions. Your contributions help with our many projects including: the building, design and creation of three Izzy spaces, as well as the many programs and activities, support groups, scholarships and our Angel Family Giving holiday program.

A NOTE FROM OUR EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR:

Thank you for making 2019 yet another remarkable year for The Izzy Foundation. Our dedicated staff, interns and volunteers have done an incredible job at expanding our outreach while strengthening our programs and services. The Izzy Foundation is stronger than ever due to our continually expanding community who come together to donate time, resources, and talents in support of our important mission. Last year alone, we expanded our meals in the Izzy Family Room to four a week, stocked and maintained a food pantry and assured that everyone had the personal hygiene supplies needed while in the hospital for long-term treatment stays. Additionally, our volunteers logged over 5,200 hours while receiving and distributing over \$128,000 of in-kind items to the families, making The Izzy Foundation and Izzy Family Room an integral part of the inpatient experience at Hasbro Children's Hospital.

One of the most exciting advancements this year was the opening of The Izzy Foundation's third 'Izzy space' and our second major gift to Hasbro Children's Hospital. The new Family Surgical Waiting Room is an Izzy Space that helps advance family-centered care by offering families a comfortable and peaceful environment. Its new consulting space provides families with extra privacy to express their emotions and discuss their child's surgical outcome. We couldn't be more excited to see this project come to fruition. This vision was birthed over three years ago, and like every project we do, we were part of every decision from the design to picking out furniture to approving art in order to ensure that we were creating a space that provides a calming environment for families. We did not do this alone, and are forever indebted to Thomas Morbitzer and his team at AM/MOR Architecture LLP who saw our vision and walked beside us to help us create a space we all can be proud of.

Since its opening in April 2014, the Izzy Family Room has become so much more than anyone anticipated. It is a place for families to come for a cup of coffee, a family dinner or to relax during long hospital stays. The room has become one of the most frequently used spaces in Hasbro Children's Hospital for inpatient families.

This year alone, our sponsors have provided over 280 meals, our amazing volunteers and interns have logged over 3,000 hours and we gave away 2,500 hygiene kits. In addition, our well-loved programs are part of each child's unique pediatric medical journey and are imprinted on our hearts as well as the hearts of the families and patients we serve.

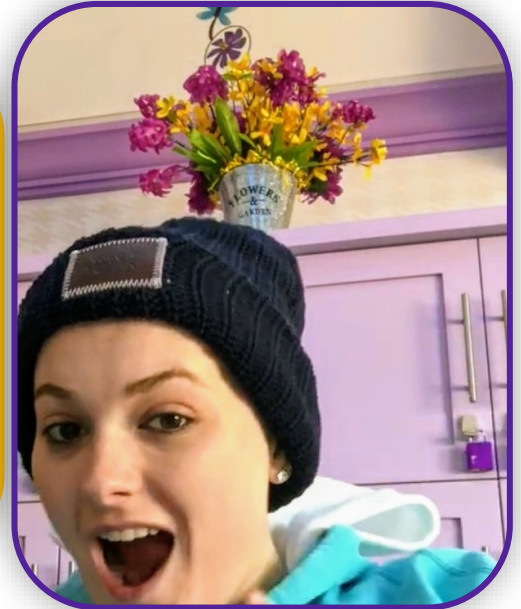

"CARRIGAN'S JOURNEY"




In February 2019, my daughter Carrigan turned 18. She was busy performing as a vocalist, and had been awarded Miss Congeniality for Miss Teen USA RI and Miss Outstanding Teen RI. She was a community volunteer, youth mentor, dog walker and was continuing her music education. She was excited for young adulthood and looking forward to the year ahead. That all changed when Carrigan began experiencing leg pain. Since she was a dancer and black belt in Taekwondo it wasn't unusual for her leg to ache, but something was different. The pain was felt deep in her bone and was becoming agonizing. After many misdiagnoses, targeted scans finally revealed a baseball sized tumor in the base of her kneecap and fibula. She was diagnosed with a high-grade Osteosarcoma, an aggressive bone cancer. She began seven months of high dose chemotherapy at Hasbro Children's Hospital in March 2019. Limb salvage surgeries followed, and our lives would change forever.

Carrigan's diagnosis brought so much uncertainty for our family. We were new to the hospital setting and once we walked through the doors we were in a different world with an unfamiliar rhythm. Luckily, the medical staff at Hasbro embraced us in every way. They went above and beyond to ensure our comfort, to provide the best care and to make Carrigan and our entire family feel supported. We were immediately introduced to the Izzy Family Room and from the second we walked in, with Carrigan's IV pole in tow, we all felt at home.

The Izzy Room became a place of joy and brought tremendous comfort and solace to our family. Carrigan had a place to visit with her friends, enjoy arts and crafts, meet new patients, grab a meal or snack and just be a teen again.

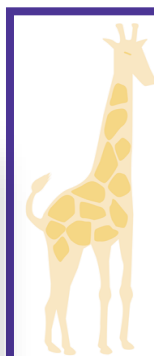

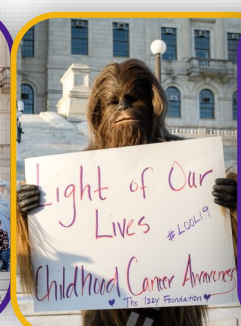
